

# Village Maintenance Report

1. **Street Maintenance:** All of the yellow lines were painted throughout the village, the white parking spot lines on Melbourne Rd., Dunster Rd., and Darley Rd. were painted also. We have been continuing cobble stone curb repairs throughout the village. Tony Manta and Greg Jurcsak have been trained and have picked up the technique quickly.
2. **Street Lighting:** I am currently in contact with N&S Electric getting a quote and time frame to order cobra head fixtures to replace the outdated ones that are out on Northern Blvd. When they arrive, I will contact Hellman Electric to come in to install them for us. We replaced one pole and light fixture that was broken from an auto accident on Melbourne Rd. We also had to get a new "Stop Ahead" sign made to replace the one that was damaged from the accident.
3. **Village Hall:** The court room door was primed and painted to match the front door. The locks for the exterior doors have all be changed and re-keyed.
4. **Equipment/Maintenance:** All Ford trucks were changed and their front ends were greased. A battery charger/tender was installed on the roller for the tennis courts. I ordered the parts for the street sweeper and will make all necessary repairs in the near future. All of the chainsaws were cleaned and sharpened in preparation for the hurricane that didn't occur.
