Re: October Maintenance Report

1. **Street Lighting:** There were two street light outages at 47 Tain Dr. and 15 Dodford Rd. which were caused by bad ballasts. We removed the fixture and replaced it with a retro-fitted LED bulb fixture. There were five cobra head style street lights out on Northern Blvd. Hinck Electrical Contractor, Inc. replaced two of the fixtures with Led heads and retro-fitted three of the fixtures to LED with corn cob style bulbs.
2. **Security Cameras:** We installed the base and conduit for future cameras to be installed at the entrance of Wensley Dr. and Tain Dr. We are currently working at the bottom of Clent Rd. and at the end of Tain Rd. by the Joyce Cohn Pathway.
3. **General Village Maintenance:** The street sweeper has been going out almost daily to keep the streets and catch basins clean of leaves. We started to do repairs on the Ford dump body in preparation of the upcoming winter. Greg Jurcsak took his CDL road test and passed. We repaired the access road at the end of Tain Dr. that washed out from the last major rain storm.
